Too me it felt like a very -none heavy product and whatever buffering agents were added were not enough to buffer the -none as I was using on 3 sparys. In contrast New Pheromone Additive (4:1) mix @ 4 sprays brings me the most blatant hits That I have ever seen.

Hits wise nothing major, just a few Deer in the headlights looks. For me it's an expensive product at \$69.95 when you can use better products at this price range.
